Description The Air Force Institute of Technology is offering summer 2026 internships at Wright Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio.

What will I be doing?

As an ORISE participant, you will join a community of scientists and researchers engaged in research activities in nuclear science, physics, engineering, and related fields.

Why should I apply?

Under the guidance of a mentor, you will engage in various research activities, including participation in the collection of experimental data, analysis of results, and simulation of environments of interest. Project focus areas may include the following disciplinary fields:

- Quantum Information and Sensing
- Nuclear Science and Weapon Effects
- Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, and Cyber Security
- Materials, Extreme Environments, and Optical Sciences
- Remote Sensing and Radiation Detection
- Hypersonics and Re-entry Vehicles

Where will I be located? Dayton, Ohio

What is the anticipated start date?

These appointments will be primarily for summer 2026, with exact start dates determined at the time of selection and in coordination with the selected candidate. Applications are reviewed on an ongoing basis and internships will be filled as qualified candidates are identified.

What is the appointment length?

Research interns are typically appointed for a term of 10 weeks, with the possibility to be renewed for additional periods. Appointments may be extended depending on funding availability, project assignment, program rules, and availability of the participant.

What are the provisions?

You will receive a stipend to be determined by AFIT. Stipends are typically based on a participant's academic standing, discipline, experience, and research facility location. Other provisions may include the following:

- Health Insurance Supplement (*Participants are eligible to purchase health insurance through ORISE*)
- Relocation Allowance
- Training and Travel Allowance
