Projects in UVDL develop remote autonomous ground and air systems to enhance national security, support nonproliferation, and serve other unique support needs within the U.S. government. The projects span a breadth of activities from sensor development, software, communication systems, electronics, aviation systems, and mechanical engineering. The candidate will work closely with senior research staff on these exciting projects.

Qualifications Candidates should have a master's degree in geography, mathematics, engineering, or related fields.

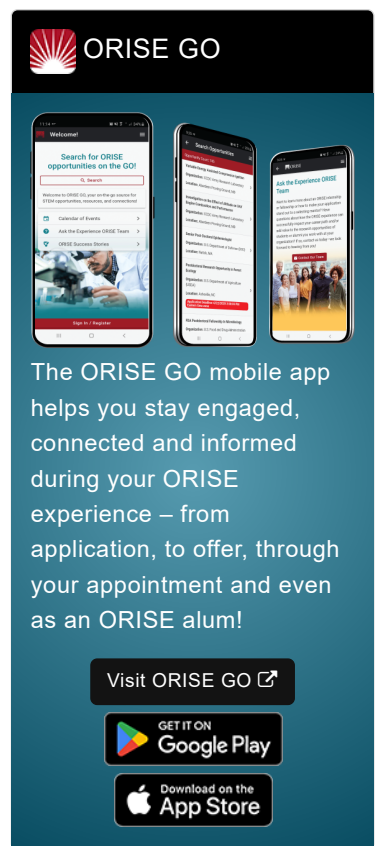
