Description The US Army Research Institute of Environmental Medicine (USARIEM) is an internationally recognized center of excellence for Warfighter health and performance. Our research studies are conducted by scientists from our four research divisions, working in concert with one another, as well as other world-class scientists from government, industry and academia. The Military Performance Division of USARIEM conducts research to enhance the performance (physical, cognitive, behavioral and psychomotor) of military occupational tasks, or to prevent performance decrements due to physical overload, nutritional imbalances, environmental and operational stresses, and musculoskeletal injuries.

The participant(s) will assist with evaluating the influence of early access to musculoskeletal (MSK) injury expertise and targeted education & training to reduce injury rates as part of a large multi-faceted research study. Through participation in this research appointment, participants will have the opportunity to expand their skill sets, and to gain valuable training and experience to further their scientific development.
